- [15] **1. Action Item: Required Administrative Items, Including 2026/27 Board Meeting Schedule and Elections.** Meeting schedule, locations, and times must be established for calendar year 2026/27 at the February 26, 2026 Board meeting. In addition, a new Chairperson and Vice Chairperson must be elected as existing terms expire after February 26, 2026. Resolution #26-01 will set the meeting dates and locations, and Resolution #26-02 will appoint the new Chairperson and Vice Chairperson.

- [15] 2. **Action Item: Legislative Platform for 2026.** District Counsel and APCO will provide an overview of the developing legislative session; review the principles of the District’s ongoing legislative platform; and receive Board input to finalize and then adopt the District’s 2026 legislative platform. Resolution #26-03 will adopt the District’s 2026 legislative platform.
- [5] 3. **Information Item: District Participation in Program: “Protecting Blue Whales Blue Skies (BWBS).”** NSCAPCD staff recommends participation in BWBS. BWBS is a voluntary Vessel Speed Reduction (VSR) program incentivizing shipping participants to reduce ship strike risk to whales, underwater noise, emissions, and air pollution by voluntarily transiting to speeds of 10 knots or less. BWBS independently verifies cooperation rates and environmental benefits. NSCAPCD participation has no fee or signing obligation and involves helping BWBS with messaging on NSCAPCD communication platforms and use of NSCAPCD logo for visibility.
